## BUS ROWDIES

In response to our complaint of disorderliness by high school students on the late afternoon buses from 169th Street, the Board of Transportation tells us that it "assigns experienced supervisory personnel to regulate and control the loading of these buses" and that "it is not possible to extend this supervision beyond this point as a matter of routine, but, when required, the services of our Transit Police Bureau have been enlisted, and more orderly procedure provided through this medium." The Board further says "the assumption of further responsibility by the Board is not considered justified in the circumstances, for if the conduct of the pupils cannot be properly influenced by home guidance and supervision appropriate law enforcement agencies must then be employed."

We believe the above needs no further comment but wish to say that the members at our last meeting decided not to let this matter rest but to go along with any drastic steps necessary to put a stop to this rowdyism.

In passing, we might relate of a similar situation in Atlantic City. The school bus drivers in that City were "fed up" with being targets for lighted cigarettes, water pistols, spitballs, blasphemy and general noise. They complained to their union and went on strike; it turned out to be a case of behave or walk.

The result: the buses resumed, proper decorum was observed and, as one driver said, "we did our job with pleasure and satisfaction to the majority of children."

**TOLL STARTS SOON**

Gov. Thomas E. Dewey signed a law to permit a ten-cent toll on the Southern State Parkway to finance a \$40,000,000 improvement of express roads on the south shore of Long Island.

The toll would be collected by the Jones Beach State Parkway Authority at booths to be erected at the Queens-Nassau line and is expected to be imposed as soon as the booths can be set up, probably by mid-spring.
