ACCESSORY DWELLING UNIT BILL CONCERNS CIVICS

A bill has been proposed in the NYS Senate (Bill S4547) and NYC Assembly (Bill A4854) regarding Accessory Dwelling Units (ADU). The legislation would allow extra dwelling units in basements, garages, etc., throughout New York State. We are concerned that this might circumvent zoning regulations and increase overcrowding. The Queens Civic Congress and Queens Community Board 13 have passed resolutions in opposition to the bill. We will discuss this at our June 14 meeting.
