PARTICIPATORY VOTING IS BACK

New York City has instituted a citywide vote on budget proposals called "The People's Money."

It allows individuals to vote on projects created by fellow New Yorkers and decide how a portion of the budget should be spent. Visit the website On.nyc.gov/pb to vote or learn more. You will be asked to enter your zip code. There is an authentication process which involves entering a code number you receive as a text message. You should then see the proposals that Queens residents can vote on. You can only vote one time, but you may vote for several proposals during that session. Voters must live in NYC and be at least 11 years old. Voting ends June 25.

BELLEROSE WAR MEMORIAL DEDICATION 6/17

Construction of the Bellerose War Memorial is underway. It is located on the center median of 239 St, just north of Hillside Ave. The dedication ceremony is scheduled for Saturday, June 17 at 1 pm. This date is the 83rd anniversary of the crash over Bellerose of two B-18 bombers on a training mission. All crew members on both planes perished, as did one civilian on the ground. The flight crews valiantly prevented further casualties on the ground by steering the planes to crash on 87 Ave and on 239 St, instead of onto homes.
