NYPD LAUNCHES COMMUNITY POLICING IN 105 PRECINCT

On April 30th, community members packed the auditorium at Queens High School for Teaching as the NYPD rolled out the Neighborhood Policing program in the 105th Precinct.

The 105th Precinct has been divided into 5 sectors. Sector Eddie will include most of Bellerose, including the Creedmoor Civic area, as well as Floral Park and Glen Oaks. Two Neighborhood Coordinating officers have been assigned to each sector. Officers Shawn Gallagher and Joseph Contessa will be the NCO's in Sector Eddie. NCO's have received extensive training, including 2 weeks of criminal investigation, and a 4-day mediation course.

NYPD Chief Fausto Pichardo explained the program. He said the NCO's roles will include crime fighting, problem solving, addressing quality of life issues, and developing relationships with members of the community. In addition to NCO's, a group of officers designated "Steady Sector Officers" will respond to 911 calls but will spend two hours per tour interacting with community members. "Response officers" will continue to handle 911 calls.

On April 28 at 11:50 pm, a fire broke out in a Queens Village private dwelling located at 93-20 211 St. The fire, which killed a 32-year-old woman and her grandparents, remains under investigation. It happened a week after the first anniversary of another fire in Queens Village that killed 3 children and 2 adults.
