ROSE DADDARIO: 1916-2014

Former Creedmoor Civic President Rose Daddario passed away on July 9 at the age of 98. Rose was one of those bigger than life personalities in the Bellerose community.

Rose was not only president of Creedmoor Civic twice, but also served on the boards of directors of the Queens Village Republican Club, the Colonial Farmhouse Restoration Society of Bellerose (dba Queens County Farm Museum), was a former member of Community Board 13, had served as president of a local senior's group, and was a fixture at the annual St. Gregory's Festival.

Rose was an outspoken representative of the neighborhood who never held back. The Creedmoor Civic gave her an award at its 85th Anniversary celebration held at the Farm Museum. The Daddarios moved to 240th Street in 1954.

Rose is survived by three children. She was grandmother to eight, and great grandmother to two. There was a funeral Mass at St. Gregory the Great and burial at Calverton National Cemetery where her husband Frank is interred.
