ASSESSED VALUATION

Taxpayers may learn the assessed valuation of their property during the period from the first day of February to the 15th of March.

During this period also, the taxpayer may file a protest, if deemed desirable, against the amount of the assessed valuation placed on his property. A protest of this kind must be filed in the Department of Taxes and Assessments, Boro Hall, Kew Gardens.
