Do not forget that they are payable during the month of January and if not paid on or before January 31st are subject to an interest charge at the rate of 7 per cent per annum from January 1st to date of payment.

Advance Notice

There is much to be said on the subject of assessed valuations now on the homes of our community.

Every year the period from February 1st to March 15th is designated in which protests must be filed if you deem the valuation placed on your property too high. Consideration, therefore, should be given the matter long before March 15.

Auto Plates

No new license plates will be distributed for 1949 but it will be necessary nevertheless, to file an application as in previous years. You will then receive a metal tab $15\% \times 31\%$ inches which is to be attached to the rear plate.

You cannot run your car after Jan. 31, 1949 without this tab. To avoid the last minute rush and possible disappointment, why not get the 1949 tab now.

We will endeavor to have a supply of application blanks at our next meeting. You may have one for the asking.

High School

On Dec. 2nd the Board of Estimate authorized the acquisition of the site for the East Queens High School.

This is a most important step. For over 20 years agitation has been going on for a high school of our own in this part of the City and the delegates of the Eastern Queens High School Committee who appeared before the Board of Estimate were elated with the great progress that was made in that decision on Dec. 2nd.

The site authorized to be acquired is situated on the northerly side of Hillside Avenue running from 229th to 232nd Streets and extending back to Seward Avenue. It is a part of the Cottage Garden Nursery property and is a desirable location, handy to bus lines and particularly to our community.

This site has an area of 510,900 square feet and has an assessed valuation of \$89,500 and because of its fairly level topography it would involve the least capital outlay for development.

The next step and most important is to have funds allocated for the actual construction of the building the cost of which is estimated at \$4,000,000.

N. Y. City collected \$16,651,415 and Nassau County \$3,384,873 from horse racing on Long Island during the year according to the State Tax Commission.

Dayton, Ohio, believed to be one of the last cities where you can ride anywhere for a nickel, has received permission to raise its fare to 71/7 cents or seven tokens for a half dollar starting January 7th.

Snow

Along with every snowfall comes red-hot discussion as to who should remove snow from around a fire hydrant; the tenant, owner, Fire Department or Sanitation Department. This is what the law says:

Section 487 b-30 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York:

"It shall be unlawful in any manner to obstruct the use of any fire hydrant, or to allow any snow or ice to be thrown or piled upon or around the same, or to place, or allow to be placed, any material, or thing in front thereof, from the curb line to the center of the street and to within ten feet from either side thereof.

"All snow and ice accumulating in the street, within such place shall be removed by the owner, lessee, or tenant of the premises fronting such space. All material or things found obstructing any fire hydrant may be forthwith removed by the officers or employees of the Fire Department, at the risk, cost and expense, of the owner or claimant. The commissioner shall take all proper measures to keep fire hydrants from freezing, and in proper condition for use at all times."
