The Board of Transportation of the City of New York approved a contract with Jamaica Post Office for one year beginning July 1, 1949 for transporting mail carriers. The city will receive \$5867.52 in 12 monthly payments. Under the terms of the contract, letter carriers, while on duty, wearing a cap and badge and carrying a regulation mail bag will be carried without payment of cash fare.
