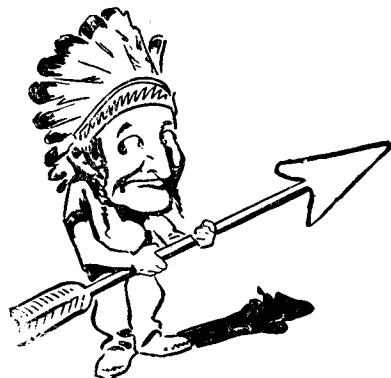

TAXES

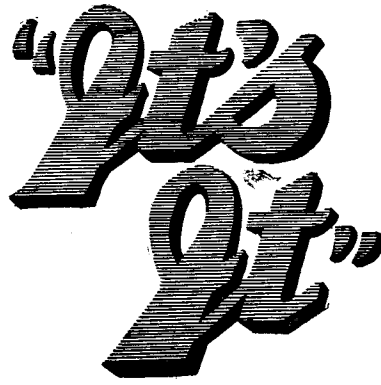
Real Estate Taxes for the first half of the fiscal year July 1, 1946 to June 30th, 1947, are due this month.

If you do not pay them on or before October 31st, you will incur an interest penalty at the rate of 7 per cent from October 1st to date of payment.

LEAVES

This is the time of the year when leaves fall and cover our lawns, sidewalks and streets. Perhaps you are not aware of it, but there is a municipal ordinance which prohibits the burning of leaves on the pavement of streets. Violators of this ordinance are subject to prosecution.

Better rake your leaves together and put them in a bag or basket for collection by the Department of Sanitation. This will keep them from being washed down the street and clogging the catchbasin on your corner. It may also save you a trip to see the judge.

The Association has received several complaints concerning the dangerous condition of sidewalks caused by roots of trees in front of homes.

This condition is entirely a responsibility of the property owner. The Park Department will send a representative who will advise what should be done to the root or the whole tree and issue the necessary permit.

A sidewalk and curb must be kept in a safe condition by the property owner and he is liable for any injuries sustained on a sidewalk or curb rendered dangerous by roots of trees or otherwise. The Administrative Code of the City of New York places this responsibility.

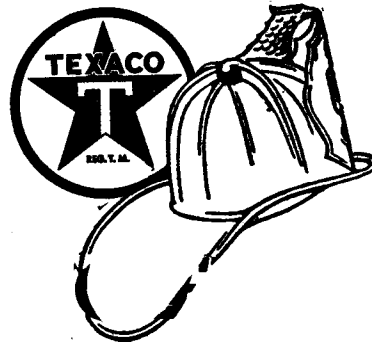
